## Outdoor & Adventure

- 1. Hold your own mini Highland Games.
- 2. Go on a short local nature walk and record some of the birds, plants, insects, and other animals that you see. Find out the names of five of these.
- 3. Take part in a virtual Nights Away experience. You can camp in your garden or indoors, as long as it's not in your bed!
- 4. Take a virtual tour of a Scottish Landmark e.g. Edinburgh Castle.
- 5. Learn some traditional Scottish playground games and try them e.g. Hopscotch.

## Skills

- 1. Learn a Scottish song or dance.
- 2. Use Scots or Gaelic words to play a game, make up a story, or create a picture.
- 3. Design and create a Tartan or Coat of Arms for your family.
- 4. Find out about a Scottish myth or legend. Re-tell this story – you could make a comic strip, perform a puppet show, or create a picture showing an important part of the story.
- 5. Make a model of Nessie or a famous Scottish landmark or building.

## World

- 1. Learn where Scotland is in the world and compare the size of Scotland to the sizes of some other countries.
- 2. Learn about some Scottish customs and food e.g. a Burns Supper. Try some of these.
- 3. Create a poster/radio advert/television advert featuring all things Scottish. Your finished piece should represent Scotland and should encourage someone from another country to visit.
- 4. Find out about some Scottish inventors and their inventions. Consider what life would be like without their inventions.
- 5. Find out 5 interesting facts about your local area. Are any popular actors/actresses, musicians/bands, or philanthropists from your town/village? What types of jobs did people living in your town/village traditionally do?

**Top Tips!** If you haven't finished your badges and challenges, you can carry on and complete them in your first term as a Cub Scout. Please note that any of these badge requirements can be done in conjunction with the UK badge programme.
