

SCIENTIST BADGE - GROWING CRESS

- Keep your pots in the bag and place in a warm place (a window sill is ideal)
- Check every day to make sure the cotton wool/kitchen towel does not dry out (add a little water if you think it is getting dry)
- Once you see small shoots (this should only take a few days), take the pots out of the bag and leave in a warm sunny place. Keep checking to make sure they do not dry out.
- After 7 days, stop watering one pot but keep it on the window sill. Put another in a dark place (inside a cupboard or box). Leave the third pot on the window sill and water it enough to keep the cotton wool/kitchen towel damp.
- A few days later compare the cress and see what has happened to it. Record what you find below and bring this sheet to cubs on 3rd December:
